

Summit Village Association Beach Club Rules and Regulations for Storage of Non-Motorized Vessels

1. A seasonal storage rack is provided for smaller non-motorized vessels near the south boundary of the Beach Club. This space is reserved for canoes, small sailboats, and similar vessels which **weigh less than 200 pounds.**
2. Storage space for non-motorized vessels is only available to Summit Village Association home, condo, or lot owners. Current association dues must be paid in full.
3. Before you store a small vessel in this area, you must first:
 - * Submit a completed "Request for Storage of a Non-Motorized Vessel".
 - * Rental fee must be paid in full at time of request.
 - * **Be assigned a numbered space on the storage rack by Beach Club staff.**
4. No refund will be given in the event that you are unable to use the storage space for all, or any portion, of the reserved time.
5. Stored vessels must be removed by 9 a.m. of the day following the last date of your rental period.

Vessels still remaining on the rack beyond that time will be removed and transported to a storage facility **at the owner's expense.**
6. No vessel may be stored directly on the ground, or in any other area not specifically designated for small vessel storage. Any such vessels will be removed and transported to a storage area **at the owner's expense.**
7. No trailers, wheels, etc. used to transport your small vessel may be left on Beach Club grounds.
8. No small vessels shall tie directly to the docks.
9. Small vessel owners and operators shall observe all governmental rules and regulations as defined by the Coast Guard safe operations procedures.
10. Small vessel operators are required to observe all Beach Club rules.
11. The Beach Club Supervisor will maintain a waiting list for storage space and honor requests on a 'date received' basis. Indications of interest must be submitted in writing.
